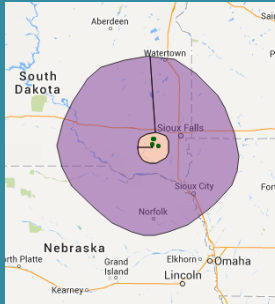


Freeman Arts/Earth Center
