Revising Our Social Media Policy

In 2014 Surrey Schools wanted to renew its policy on the responsible use of Information and Communications Technologies. PlaceSpeak's online engagement platform provided the perfect opportunity to legitimately consult with a larger verified audience within the geographic boundaries of their catchment area.

The engagement was a success with 90 connected participants and over 62 comments as part of the discussion.

The success of the first consultation in reaching a large audience demonstrated the advantages of online engagement. A second consultation was conducted which looked to engage parents on the future of the school district's programs.

For Surrey Schools second consultation they were able to connect with 238 verified participants and received 181 comments, more than doubling the level of engagement.

Serving over 72,000 students, Surrey Schools has the highest student enrolment in the province and is one of the few growing school districts in British Columbia. Comprised of 101 elementary schools, 19 secondary schools, 5 student learning centres and 3 adult education centres, the school district is governed by an elected board of seven trustees representing the cities of Surrey and White Rock.

Parent involvement is welcomed at Surrey Schools and the Parent Advisory Councils (PACs) are valued as active partners in education. PACs are active at both the elementary and secondary levels and have representation on the District Parent Advisory Council and many district committees.
