By using PlaceSpeak, the City of Fort St. John has expanded its capacity to engage citizens while gathering valuable input from the public.

PlaceSpeak has launched *Neighbourhoods* in seven community areas in Fort St. John which include Downtown, Annofield, Camarlo Park-Mathews Park, Northeast Fort St. John, Northwest Fort St. John, Prospect Park and South Lagoon.
