Former Premier of Tasmania, Australia joins PlaceSpeak's Board

Vancouver, BC Canada - Michael Harcourt, Chair of PlaceSpeak's Board of Directors has announced the appointment of David Bartlett, former Premier of Tasmania, Australia, to the board of the Vancouver-based technology company. PlaceSpeak has developed an innovative on-line public engagement platform that is now widely used in Canada and is now being adopted for use by regional governments in the US.

Mr. Bartlett, who served as premier from 2008 to 2011 was recently named as one of Australia's fifty most influential people in technology. He says PlaceSpeak has 'tremendous potential' to democratize power and influence across a broader base of public participants in Australia and elsewhere.

"PlaceSpeak is a form of electronic 'town hall' where people can have genuine dialogue on matters of importance to their communities," he says. "Decision-makers have been reluctant to engage the public on-line because so many processes turn into a free-for-all of often toxic exchanges from anonymous people with little direct connection to a community. This does nothing to support good public policy.

PlaceSpeak uses 'geo-authentication', which allows people to claim their location in a neighbourhood and provide community and business leaders with specific issues and perspectives from those who are most invested in the ultimate decision. Bartlett says this generates better input for decision-makers and boosts public confidence in the consultation process.

"Anyone who's accountable to the public knows that how decisions are made are often as important to citizens as the decisions themselves," he says.

Mr. Harcourt, who was Vancouver's Mayor from 1980 to 1986 and Premier of British Columbia from 1991 to 1996, says Mr. Bartlett's appointment to the Board will further strengthen PlaceSpeak's growth potential. "As premiers, both David and I gained a very unique perspective of the value of genuine public dialogue. David's technology credentials coupled with his political experience makes him a unique 'find' to join the leadership of a very unique company," he says.

"Earlier this month, PlaceSpeak was recognized by the technology consulting firm Rocket Builders as one of BC's 'Emerging Rockets' because of its growth potential. We have also just completed a successful round of seed financing that has positioned us to realize that potential," Harcourt added.
